

On 24th September 2019, Angus our grandson was diagnosed with an aggressive blood cancer, T-cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia (T-ALL). He is one of under 100 children in the UK each year who receive this devastating diagnosis.

Despite chemotherapy starting immediately, for a while Angus counted as a 'slow responder'. All of our world was turned upside down. Explaining to your nine-year old that his platinum blonde hair will soon be left in a halo on the pillow is the least of it. We have been humbled by the extraordinary support from incredible teams at the Royal Marsden, St. George's and Evelina hospitals and an overwhelming response from family and friends. The planned chemo treatment last a tortuous 3.5 years of which the first 8 months are the most brutal. Throughout his treatment Angus has maintained his spirit and as a family they wanted to help raise money for Childhood cancer research. Every penny will go towards the Royal Marsden Cancer charity.
